Current Pro Player Ranking

The ranking system is based heavily on the player's performance in his best four of the last five pro tournaments. The criteria used for ranking are total prize money won, total points earned, the average number of points earned at each tournament played, and the player's composite performance on the tour over the last year.

This is how the pros will be seeded for the first pro stop of the 1984-85 season. The top-12-ranked pros are automatically invited. If one or more are unable to attend, players ranked 13 and lower are used as alternates.
